Spresiano is a town in the **Treviso** province, situated around 13 km to the north of Treviso and about 40 km north of **Venice**. Nestled just before the foothills of the **Dolomite Mountains**, it is easily accessible from both Treviso and Conegliano. Known for being part of the **Prosecco** wine region, Spresiano is included in the popular wine itineraries. The town has roots that date back to Roman times and was strategically positioned along the Claudia Augustus trade route, which connected Altino to the Danube River.

Le Bandie Sports Center was born from the project of redeveloping a former quarry area. In 2002, the property, Mosole Spa, received the **European Restoration Award** in Brussels for the best intervention on abandoned quarries. This transformation effort began in the 1980s with the renovation of the 17th-century Cà Ballarin barns, two buildings of significant historical value located on top of a small hill overlooking the lake. Today, the former quarry is a small **oasis of peace and tranquility** just a stone's throw from the city, a destination for nature walks, relaxation, and sports enthusiasts, featuring a **Swimming Center**, a Hotel with a wellness center – the **Thai Si Hotel & Royal Thai Spa**, a restaurant, **Habitat Le Bandie**, and a center for the development of new sports and health initiatives. Le Bandie has hosted several **sports events**, including the 2021 Italian Dragon Boat Championships, the 2023 Gravel Bike World Championships, the 2016 Veneto Regional Canoe Sprint Championships, and the 2008 UCI Cyclocross World Championships.

TRAVEL INFO

The Race Venue is located about 20 minutes from Treviso and 40 minutes from Venice (and respective airports).

BY CAR

Lago Le Bandie can be reached from Germany (Brennero pass, A22 then either the A4 or SPV-Pedemontana), from Austria (A23 /Tarvisio), from Slovenia (A34 Gorizia or A4 Trieste), while from Italy take the A27 Belluno highway.

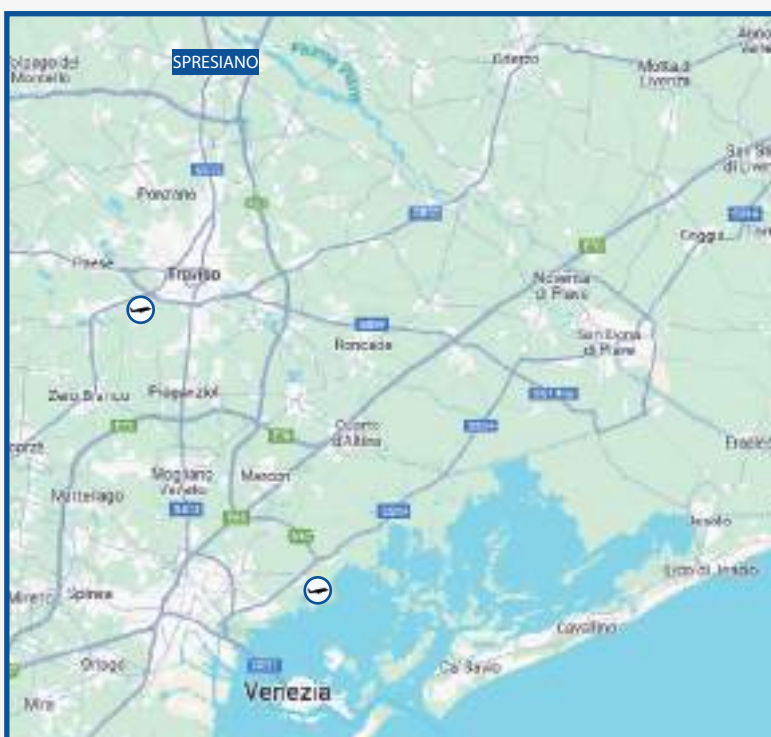
BY PLANE

BY TRAIN

The closest railway station is Spresiano (4 km from race venue).





ENTRIES AND ACCREDITATION

Accreditations and team registrations will be done through a specific platform that will be provided to you. You can register for International Race and Coppa Italia events separately.

ACCREDITATION FEE

International Race

Accreditation fee per person per one type of races:

- € 50 - for senior and master athletes
- € 40 - for junior, paradrone and BCS athletes
- € 10 - for all other members of a team (per person): coaches, staff members, functionaries, who benefit of all the services, without use of the boats

The Host Organising Committee asks for a deposit of € 100,00 to be paid together with the Preliminary Entries. This amount is non-refundable.

Coppa Italia

Dragon boat rental fee for clubs (not refundable):

- Small Boat: € 50,00
- Standard Boat: € 100,00

In addition, the following registration fee applies for each athlete per race:

- €6 - for all categories
- €15 - for master athletes

Accreditation fee includes:

- accreditation;
- access and common use of the venue and facilities (excluding the swimming pool area which has a separate entrance fee);
- use of boats for training and for the races;
- access with own transport to reserved parking areas;
- free mineral water on the competition days;
- security services in the athlete's area;
- medical services at the venue;
- insurance coverage of the event (from 09.05.25 to 11.05.25)



PAYMENT TERMS

All fees must be paid by the dates indicated in the following deadlines.

INTERNATIONAL RACE

- Preliminary Entry and First deposit (€ 100) by 01.04.25
- First Participation fee – 50% of total by 21.04.25
- Final Accreditation fee – 50% of total by 01.05.25

COPPA ITALIA

- Participation fee by 28.04.25
- Participation fee for each athlete by 28.04.25

PENALTIES

INTERNATIONAL RACE

The following cancellation penalties will apply:

- Cancellation up until 21.03.25: full refund of Preliminary accreditation fees.
- Cancellation between 22.04.25 and 01.05.25: penalty of 50% of fees.
- Cancellation from 02.05.25: penalty of 100% for the accreditation fees.

In the case of a withdrawal of an athlete, the fee already paid can be used to register a different athlete without any extra cost or added costs up until the payment deadline.

The same procedure will apply for the accreditation of a team leader or assistant.

The accreditation fees will not be refunded, except upon cancellation of the event.

BOATS

Dragon boats – standard and small - will be supplied by the Organising Committee.

TRAINING SESSIONS

Training sessions before the beginning of the event will be available from Wednesday 7 May 2025. Information on how to book will be provided in the next Bulletins.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

A daily shuttle service between the hotel and the competition venue will be provided. The price will be determined based on the location of stay of the various teams.

PARKING

For teams who come with their own transport, a dedicated parking area will be reserved at the venue.

Please advise if you are coming with your own transport and what type (bus, vans etc).

For those who wish to use their own transport – athletes, spectators etc - parking areas have been organised on the grounds of the race venue.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

During the event, the participants will be covered by insurance taken out by the Host Organising Committee specific for the event.

A medical service will be available during the event.

Whoever wants greater insurance and medical cover, it is recommended that a personal policy be stipulated in the country of origin that is valid in the entire European territory. The costs above the regular medical services provided at the race venue are to be covered by the individual's medical insurance policy -the Organising Committee does not take responsibility for such expenditures.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the event will be English.

OFFICIAL CURRENCY

Payments will be accepted in Euros only.



RACE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The ICF Dragon Boat race rules and regulations will be used for this event.
