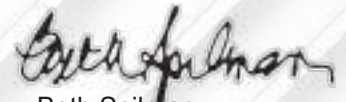

RIVERSPORT OKC

RIVERSPORT and the Boathouse District are located adjacent to downtown Oklahoma City at the intersection of highways I-35 and I-40, the crossroads of the nation. The \$100M+ development includes a series of iconic boathouses built along the Oklahoma River as well as outdoor adventure activities including a six-story adventure course, a surfing experience, an 80-ft freefall experience, climbing, and recreational kayaking.

RIVERSPORT's \$45M whitewater center offers a full range of whitewater paddling opportunities including freestyle, slalom, kayak cross, rafting and even whitewater tubing.

RIVERSPORT is a **US Olympic and Paralympic Training Site** and hosts national and international canoe slalom races on the whitewater course, and national and international rowing and canoe sprint regattas on the adjacent Oklahoma River – the only permanently lighted race venue in the world.

RIVERSPORT is also located within **walking distance of downtown's Bricktown entertainment district** which means great hotels, restaurants and entertainment are just steps away. The venue is also a trailhead on the City's 100+ miles of paved trails for cycling and running.

Local Attractions

During the World Championships, America will be celebrating the **100th Anniversary of Route 66**, the “mother road” that was the first to cross the US connecting Chicago to Los Angeles. Fun Fact: Oklahoma has more miles of this iconic highway than any other state and has many celebrations planned throughout the summer – RIVERSPORT will be recognizing the anniversary with a Route 66 Classic Car Show during the Championships, and athletes will be invited to “get their kicks on Route 66” with special excursions.

4 COMPETITION VENUE

RIVERSPORT Rapids was built in 2016 and has hosted numerous national and international competitions including Canadian and US Olympic Team Trials for Canoe Slalom, PanAmerican Slalom Championships and a 2025 ICF Canoe Slalom World Ranking event.

The course is 305 meters (1,000 feet) long and drops 5.1 meters (16' 9") from start to finish. This recirculated water pumped course is estimated to be level WW III-IV at 10 m³/s (350 ft³/s) flows during a competition.

6 ENTRIES & PARTICIPATION FEE

Entry Process & Deadlines

Entries and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP). SDP user guide link: <https://www.canoeicf.com/sports-data-platform>

For detailed instructions on how to submit entries, please read the SDP user guide. Any questions or issues relating to entries or accreditation should be sent to sdp@canoeicf.sport prior to the respective deadline.

Numerical Entries

Numerical entries close: 5 June 2026

You must submit through SDP the number of athletes you will enter into each event.

Please also give indicative numbers for the overall number of athletes and team personnel who will attend the event with your delegation.

Nominal Entries

Nominal entries close: 10 July 2026

Each athlete competing must be entered by name.

Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce accreditation cards for all teams.

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organizer will NOT be accepted.

Participation Fee

A Participation Fee of \$280 USD will be charged for each accredited athlete and team official, to cover the duration of the Official Training and Competition phases of the 2026 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships. National Federations will be invoiced for their share of the ITO fee by the HOC prior to the competition. The Participation Fee will include the following services:

- Accreditation
- Access to Athlete Village
- Nations tent
- Technical video signal
- Boat storage
- Security
- Public wifi access in venue
- Team parking
- Information regarding the accommodation
- Scheduled gym training sessions
- Free training during the Official Training Period immediately adjacent to the World Championships; Official Pre-Championship training periods in March/April are not free
- Emergency first aid
- Flat-water training



Free accreditation will be provided for the NF President, the NF General Secretary, and ITOs selected by the ICF.

Bank Details

The participation fees must be paid by bank transfer before the arrival at RIVERSPORT. No other payment method is available.

8 TRAINING

Official Pre Championship Training Periods

- Training Period (1) 16 – 26 March 2026
- Training Period (2) 30 March 2026 – 3 April 2026

One (1) training slot per day per athlete will be guaranteed during these training periods for both Slalom and Kayak Cross. Kayak Cross training sessions will be scheduled for every other day at a minimum. For the March/April weeks, the HOC will provide two slots per day for slalom paddlers if capacity permits.

To register for training during these periods please use the ICF SDP system. The deadline to register for the pre-event training periods is 4 weeks prior to the respective training weeks:

- Training Period (1) week registration deadline – 16 February 2026
- Training Period (2) week registration deadline – 2 March 2026

To provide equitable training opportunities, the ICF does not permit teams to book additional training sessions with the venue during these weeks.

Official Training Periods

- Official Training takes place 12 – 19 July 2026

One (1) training slot per day and per athlete for slalom plus one training slot per day per athlete for kayak cross. Kayak Cross training sessions will be scheduled for every other day at a minimum.

9 ATHLETE SERVICES

Athlete Facilities at the Venue

The following facilities will be provided for all accredited athletes and team personnel during the official training and competition phases:

- Athlete Village
- Athlete Lounge
- Nation tents
- Toilets
- Boat Storage



Additional toilets, changing rooms and showers are provided in the main center.

Catering outlets onsite will provide nutritional options for purchase to cater for athletes and team personnel.

Athlete Services at the Venue

The following services will be provided to all accredited athletes and team personnel during the official training and competition phases:

- **Video Service** - TV located in the Athlete Lounge to allow teams to watch the competition.
- **Internet Access** – Public internet access throughout the Athlete Village.
- **Drinking Water** - Access to drinking water for all accredited athletes. We encourage the use of reusable water bottles and discourage the use of single-use plastic bottles.
- **Refreshments** - Quality outlets will be available throughout the training and competition period for athletes to purchase food and drink. In addition, complimentary fresh fruit and snacks are provided in the Athlete Lounge.
- **Boat Repair** - space will be provided for teams to undertake boat repairs.



10 ACCOMMODATIONS

RIVERSPORT OKC has partnered with HBC Event Services to provide the best published refundable rates and outstanding service when booking your accommodations. All teams traveling to the competition that require overnight accommodations should book their accommodations through our official hotel provider - HBC Event Services. To ensure a smooth and organized 2026 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships experience, we have implemented a Support the Sport policy.

Booking Guidelines

Teams should book all their rooms through the event's official hotel provider for this event. Hotel reservations should be made by the team manager or designated representative no later than **1 July 2026**, as that is the latest block release date we have set with the hotels.

Only hotels listed through the event's official housing provider will count toward meeting the Support the Sport policy.

- **Convenience** Teams can focus on the competition knowing that accommodations are taken care of with vetted, team-friendly hotels.
- **Cost-Effectiveness** Negotiated rates offer discounted pricing, keeping costs reasonable for all participants. Our hotel partner, HBC, negotiates discounted group rates with top hotels near the venue. This means your teams get high-value lodging at rates lower than booking independently. HBC also negotiates protection clauses in place with each hotel to help protect your reservations against things like event cancellation, and hotel rate integrity.

Reservation Process

Select from the approved list of hotels and select "Hold Block" to create a block of rooms for your team's needs. There is no payment or credit card required at this time. Once the block is created, you will receive an email with more details as well as a link that should be sent to all teams so that they can book (with credit card details) their room from within the team block.

- **Changes and Cancellations** Any changes to room bookings or cancellations must be made directly through the official hotel provider and adhere to their policies. Please refer to the hotel's specific terms for changes and cancellation deadlines to avoid penalties.
- **Travel Protection Plan** You can purchase a Travel Protection Plan with up to 100% for covered cancellations reasons as well as a Cancel for Any Reason benefit of 75% coverage of your unused non-refundable prepaid expenses for travel arrangements you paid for your trip, including the event registration costs. We encourage you to book your hotel reservation and select YES to add the Travel Protection.

11 TRANSPORTATION TO OKLAHOMA CITY

Located at the crossroads of the nation at the intersection of interstate highways I-35, I-40 and I-44, Oklahoma City is as easy to reach as it is to navigate. With more than 2,400 miles of four-lane roads, it has been ranked as the sixth most drivable city in the U.S.

Airports | OKC & DFW

Will Rogers World Airport (OKC-Oklahoma City) offers nonstop air service to 20 destinations in the U.S., including west and east coast cities, and anticipates offering international service to Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean in 2026. RIVERSPORT is a 15 minute drive from the airport.

Dallas/Ft Worth International Airport (DFW-Dallas, TX) also offers service to 73 international destinations as well as numerous direct flights to Oklahoma City daily. The airport offers all major car rental companies; it is a three-hour drive from the airport to downtown Oklahoma City.

Airport to Hotel Transportation

Many hotels offer shuttle service to the airport; please check with your hotel directly for details.

- **Taxi Service** Taxis are located in the Transportation Plaza accessed from the baggage claim (lower) level. Average fare from the airport to downtown is \$30.

The HOC will provide paramedics (EMTs) on site to treat minor injuries and triage emergency situations. All participants are responsible to arrange, at their cost, their own medical insurance policy to cover any medical needs including emergency medical costs.

Qualified water safety personnel will be onsite during competition.

The following hospitals include full medical facilities including accident and emergency departments (distances from RIVERSPORT):

- University of Oklahoma Medical Center - (2.2 miles)
- McBride Orthopedic Hospital - (7.6 miles)
